Families of all returning students must complete the process to confirm the school their child plans to attend in the 2020-21 school year. Additionally, students who want to attend a non-designated school need to make that request through the returning student registration process acceptance is based on available space. The 2020-21 returning student registration takes place between Feb. 1-29, 2020.
